STURT ARTIST IN RESIDENCE PROGRAM

Sturt invites applications from experienced craft practitioners. Residencies are available in the disciplines of ceramics, jewellery, textiles, wood, photography and writing. Up to 8 residencies occur at Sturt each year.

The residency program is an important component of Sturt's integrated philosophy of overall support for Australian contemporary craft and design that also includes teaching, retail, exhibitions and studio production. Sturt encourages applications from artists who demonstrate an appreciation of this philosophy and who will make best use of the many opportunities that are available to artists at Sturt.

Three categories of residency are available:

1. Professional Residency

This category is aimed at high profile applicants, who welcome the opportunity to develop new work within the multi-disciplined craft environment of Sturt. Each applicant must have considerable experience as a maker and/or exhibitor to be considered for this program. Up to four professional residencies will be awarded annually for periods of 3 months.

Residents in this category will receive a stipend and materials allowance, studio space, accommodation, teaching and retail opportunities.



2. Self Directed Residency

This category is aimed at experienced applicants, who welcome the opportunity to develop work within the multi-disciplined craft environment of Sturt. Each applicant must have experience as a maker to be considered for this program. Residency period is a minimum of 2 months. No stipend.

Residents in this category will receive studio space, subsidised accommodation and retail opportunities.

3. Graduate Residency

This category is restricted to recent graduates from NSW and the ACT and is available only in the studios of ceramics, textiles or jewellery. A graduate residency is available for a period of six weeks. Applicants for this category must show the ability to work safely and independently (a letter signed by their tutor to confirm this).

Residents in this category will receive studio space, accommodation, promotional assistance and a small stipend.
